

English

The English Department minors are open to students enrolled in any undergraduate college at the University. The minors require 18-24 credits, six of which must be at the 300 level or above. Students who choose to do a minor in English should consult with an English Department advisor. The department offers the following minors:

General:

This minor consists of 18-24 credits of course work including six credits at the 300 level or above.

English Writing

The minor offers the students an opportunity to focus on journalism, creative an/or professional writing. The minor consists of 18-24 credits.

A student in the Writing minor **must** take

1. 42.277 Essay Writing for English Majors or 42.229 Essay Writing for Non-English Majors
2. At least two 300 or 400 level writing courses
3. English Department electives

The Department recommends that writing minors take 42.308 Analysis or Modern English.

Note: 42.101 and 42.102 **do not** count toward the English minors.
