

## Coordinator of Nursing Diversity Support Services

The Coordinator of Diversity Support Services will mentor/advise as well as coordinate planned retention activities for Bring Diversity to Nursing (BDN) enrolled students. This will include providing academic support by attending classes, conducting class and exam reviews, determining the pool of candidates who meet eligibility, and planning and implementing various extracurricular social/cultural nursing events. The successful applicant will have a MS in Nursing preferred, BS in Nursing required, with requisite clinical practice experience and experience with teaching, group work and solid computer skills. A Massachusetts RN license and minimum of 2 years' full-time nursing experience are required. Bilingual skills strongly desired. This position is a half-time non-benefited position.

Initial review of applications began on August 19, 2009 and will continue until the position is filled. Underrepresented minorities are strongly encouraged to apply.
