This position is a full-time substitute (i.e. non-tenure track) faculty position renewable each semester for a maximum of 2 years (four semesters). The position requires a combination of teaching and academic advising responsibilities and will be at the Instructor, Assistant or Associate Professor level depending upon the degrees and experience of the candidate.

CUNY is establishing NYC's first public and collaborative School of Public Health, with a focus on urban health, chronic diseases, population aging and health equity. The CUNY SPH is a collaboration between the public health programs at Hunter, Brooklyn and Lehman Colleges and the Graduate Center. Building on the strengths of the nation's largest urban public university, the planned SPH will provide MPH and DrPH graduates with the applied technical and leadership tools they need to create healthier communities. The EOHS program at the newly formed City University of New York School of Public Health offers a CEPH accredited MPH and DPH degree as well as an ABET accredited MS-Industrial Hygiene. ## **Duties:**

This faculty member will be responsible for teaching graduate (and possibly undergraduate) courses across the environmental and occupational health sciences curriculum, such as: environmental health; air and water pollution; industrial hygiene, environmental laboratory, noise and radiation.

Opportunities for collaborative research with other School of Public Health faculty exist. Additional duties will include student advisement, participation in college and university seminars and committees.

Doctoral degree in public health, industrial hygiene, environmental health, environmental sciences or a related field preferred as well as college level teaching experience. Minimum qualification of a Master's Degree.
