



## **FACULTY POSITION BIostatistics/EPIDEMIOLOGY**

The Department of Work Environment at the University of Massachusetts Lowell invites applications for a state-supported, tenure-track faculty position in Biostatistics/Epidemiology. The successful applicant will join a unique graduate program internationally known for interdisciplinary research linking science to public health action. Research in the Department focuses on injury, respiratory disease, reproductive and social epidemiology, urban, environmental and community health, risks from the proliferation of new technologies and services, and the musculoskeletal and psychosocial stresses and strains of globalized workplaces of the 21st century. The Department is located in the School of Health and Environment (SHE) on the Lowell campus of the University of Massachusetts, less than an hour north of Boston.

Responsibilities of the position will include teaching graduate and undergraduate biostatistics, supervision of graduate students, development of a program of research, university service, and collaboration in an interdisciplinary teaching and research environment. The successful candidate will be expected to develop an independent program of research supported by extramural funding. Experience in grant writing is preferred. Applicants are sought for the ranks of Assistant or Associate Professor. Preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate success in teaching quantitative research methods to diverse student populations.
