Declaration of Finances For Issuance of Student Visa Document

The attached *Declaration of Finances Form* must be submitted to the International Students & Scholars Office at the University of Massachusetts Lowell, prior to the issuance of a student visa document (i.e., for issuance of either F-1, Form I-20 or J-1, Form DS-2019). The attached form must be returned with financial documentation verifying that the student has the necessary funding, as per Estimate below.

- A copy of your Admissions Acceptance Letter
- Financial Documentation
- A copy of student's Passport Identification Page(s)
- Student must have paid \$4,000 towards their first semester bill
- Student must have paid the International Student Fee of \$150, or include a check payable to "UMass Lowell". If you want to pay by telephone, call the UMass Lowell Treasury Office at 978-934-3593.
- Students TRANSFERRING from another U.S. College, must complete an *International Student Transfer Form*
