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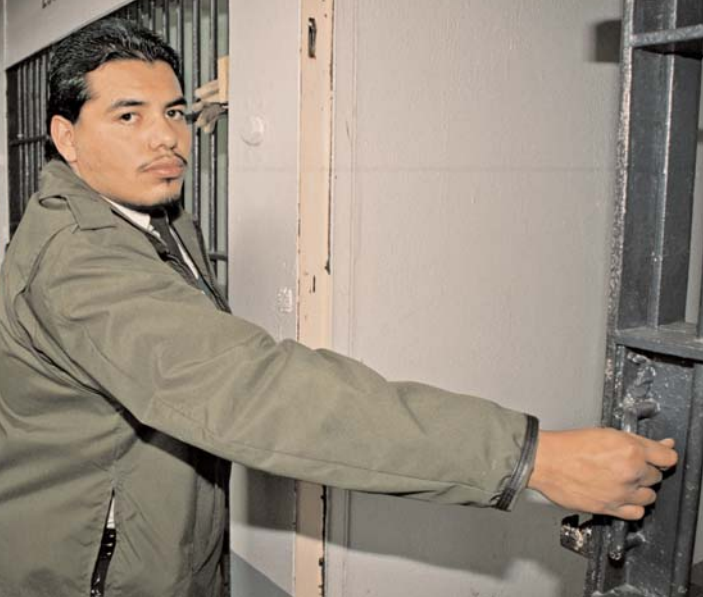

- Reducing of workplace constraints on healthy behaviors

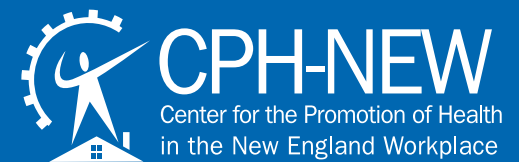


- CPH-NEW is a research-to-practice initiative funded in 2006 by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH).
- CPH-NEW staff will design and implement workplace ergonomic interventions and health promotion activities with a strong emphasis on employee involvement in program development.
- All CPH-NEW projects seek systematic approaches to enhancing workplace support of health-promoting behaviors.
- Outcomes of particular interest are musculoskeletal health, mental health, and cardiovascular health.



CPH-NEW Objectives

- Evaluate several models for integrating workplace health promotion with occupational ergonomic and mental health interventions to improve employee health.
- Quantify the health benefits and cost-effectiveness of such approaches.



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
