**The History Major, 2003 and subsequently  
General Requirements**

The major consist of 36-45 credits in History with at least 15 credits at the 300/400 levels. Students must earn an average GPA in the major of 2.2.

**Required courses:**

- 43.105 Western Civilization
  - 43.106 The Modern World
  - 43.111 US History to 1877 ***OR*** 43.112 US History since 1877
  - 43.298 Historical Methods
- Historical Methods should be taken no later than the junior year.

History majors should plan to complete the relevant survey courses before they take courses at the 300 levels or above.

**Additional courses required for the major:**

Completion of 6 credits (2 courses above the 100 level) from each of the following three groups:

- U.S. History
- European History
- Global, Comparative, and Under-represented populations

For courses in each group, see the History Department Web Site.

**Recommendation:**

It is strongly recommended that students who anticipate entering the Graduate School of Education at UMass Lowell complete 45 credits in history, including both halves of the US History survey, and the following courses:

- 43.310 History of New England
- 43.432 Research Seminar

Students who anticipate entering a graduate or professional program other than the College of Education should plan to complete 45 credits (unless they are earning a second major), including the following course:

- 43.432 Research Seminar
