

**General Requirements
(For Students entering Fall 2010 and beyond)**

A major in sociology consists of **36 to 45** credits with at least 21 credits at the 300 level or above (includes required and elective courses in the major). Required are 48.101 Introduction to Sociology or 48.102 Social Anthropology, two theory courses 48.321 and 322 and two research courses 48.402 and 403. NOTE: Students may not exceed the maximum of 45 credits of Sociology department courses. At least 75 credits must be earned outside of the major including general education requirements and free electives.

Students transferring to the college and wishing to major in sociology must make individual arrangements with the department chairperson regarding satisfaction of major course requirements.
