

Theater Arts

The interdisciplinary minor in Theater Arts offers students professional instruction and supervision in the practical work of theater together with critical study of the history and forms of dramatic literature. The minor consists of 18 to 24 credits, with at least 2 courses at the 300 level or above. Students should take 59.219, Introduction to Theatre, at the beginning of their coursework. The remaining courses should be distributed among the following three categories

1. Theatre arts workshops: at least 6 credits
2. Dramatic literature or music. At least 6 credits
3. Practicum in theatre. 3 credits. (A part-time, full semester internship at a professional theatre. Must be arranged through the Director during pre-registration period.)
