Post-doctoral Fellowship in Environmental Epidemiology

A post-doctoral fellowship is available in a dynamic, rapidly expanding university-based research environment with a team of epidemiologists, biostatisticians and exposure experts. While team members work on a wide variety of projects, the core activities for this position relate to analysis of a lung cancer case-control study that has been carried out. In addition to analyses of unique environmental/occupational data, the study provides a platform for methodological investigations and for new piggyback data collection of such information as bio-specimens (for genetic studies), domestic radon or urban air pollution. The candidate will have the opportunity to develop new projects.

The position is available for two years. Stipend \$43,000 - \$50,000 (partially tax-exempt).

The locale, Montreal, is the most cosmopolitan and affordable big city in North America.

Candidates should have a doctorate in epidemiology, or a medical degree with experience in analysis of epidemiologic studies. Strong analytic skills are required as is an ability to write clearly in English.
