Chancellor Moloney Update

- Chancellor Moloney appeared before the Faculty Senate body to provide an update. She indicated that she wanted to meet with the Faculty Senate. UMass Boston is currently in a tough position reminiscent of what UMass Lowell experienced 10 years previously. Things on this campus are looking good thanks to the faculty and staff. Enrollment is being managed very strategically. We are

becoming more like private schools where we depend on our enrollment to support us. Enrollment is a key focus for everyone on campus. Reaching our targets was nothing short of remarkable. She thanked everyone for their hard work. Identifying space where we have capacity to grow is a priority. UMass Lowell applications are up by a remarkable 25% Plant Facilities is investing a lot in remediating neglect in particular facilities. The Perry and Pasteur buildings will be renovated. The state has approved monies to renovate Coburn Hall. Chancellor Moloney thanked Faculty Senators for their service in assuring that programs are of the highest quality.
