**Honors Fellows Scholarship Application
(Current Students)**

Description

The Honors Scholarship Fund, sustained through donations by members of the University community, is an endowed fund created for the purpose of providing merit-based awards to students enrolled in the Honors Program at the University of Massachusetts Lowell. The Honors Endowment Committee will confer scholarships each year. The number of awards and the amount of each award will be determined by available funds and by the quality of the applications.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to apply for an Honors Fellows Scholarship, a student

- must be enrolled in the Honors Program at the University of Massachusetts Lowell, and;
- must have a GPA of at least 3.25

Selection Criteria

Scholarship winners will be chosen on the basis of their essay and letter of recommendation; service and leadership activities; level of involvement with the Honors Program; overall GPA; GPA in honors courses; and research activities (if any), including presentations and conferences.

Application Procedure

Eligible students wishing to apply for an Honors Fellows Scholarship should submit the following items by February 15, 2006 to the Honors Program Office (Southwick 320):

- an Honors Fellows Scholarship Application Form;
- a CV listing your service and leadership activities, Honors Program activities, and research activities (if any), as well as any other academic qualifications you wish to include.
- a 2-page (400-600) word essay describing more fully the activities listed in your CV, as well as a statement of what you contribute to the Honors Program, and what you hope to gain from the Honors Program.
- a letter of recommendation, preferably from a faculty member who can attest to your academic potential.
