Senior Research Grant Application

Description

The Honors Program will award grants of up to \$500 for materials and/or activities (including travel) related to a student's senior project or thesis. The number of grants awarded will be determined by available funding. We anticipate awarding five grants of up to \$500 for the spring semester.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for a Senior Research Grant, a student must be engaged in a senior project or thesis directed by a faculty member.

Selection criteria

Grants will be awarded on the basis of

- Merit, organization, and methodology of the proposal;
- Relevance of the budget items to the project; and
- Plans for presenting and/or publishing the work

Application procedure

Students who wish to apply for a Senior Research Grant should submit a proposal to the Honors Program Office (Southwick 320) no later than December 14, 2007 at 5:00 pm.

The proposal *must* contain the following items:

- The Senior Research Grant Application Form (attached)
- A 100-word abstract of the proposed research
- A CV for the student applicant
- A project proposal no more than 2 pages in length
- A budget for the proposed project, with an explanation of each item for which funding is requested, including its relevance to the project
- A plan for presenting and/or publishing the work funded

Proposals will be reviewed by an Honors Council faculty committee

Deadline

Applications must be received in the Honors Office (SO 320) or O'Leary 5th floor with the honors TA in the Graduate School of Education before

5:00 p.m., Friday, December 14, 2007

Grant recipients will be notified by the end of the Fall semester.
