1. Fill out the application form as completely as possible.
2. If you print the information make sure it is legible.
3. Local Phone number should be the best number to reach you at on a regular basis.
4. We must have your overall GPA. You can find your most up-to-date cumulative GPA by going to your ISIS account and clicking on Academic Records > View My Grades-> Most Current Term.
5. As you complete each section be sure to indicate what positions you may have held in an organization (i.e. President, Secretary, committee chair or member) and how long you were involved. (i.e. September 2008-May 2010) or Dean's List Honors, Spring 2009, Fall 2009, Spring 2010 or Hockey Intramurals Team Captain, Spring 2010. Participation points are awarded based on participation level and length of service. Please provide both for each organization and/or activity to receive full consideration.
