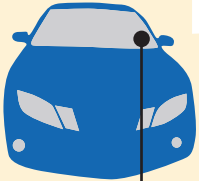
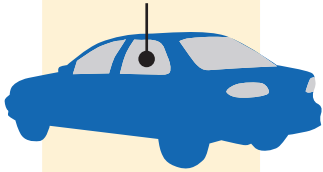


Your Parking Decal

Enclosed is the parking decal you requested on our website or in our office. Your decal must be affixed to your rear driver's side window, or for vehicles with no rear window or tinted windows, on the driver's side windshield (see diagram).

On most vehicles the permit goes in the rear driver's side window.



On vehicles with no rear window or tinted windows the permit goes on the driver's side windshield.

All parking decals expire on August 31 of each year and must be renewed. You will need to order a new decal if you obtain another vehicle, change license plates, change status to/from commuter/resident/faculty/staff, or change residential campuses.

If you are temporarily bringing a loaned or rented vehicle to campus you must visit the UCAPS Office, in advance if possible, to get a temporary hang tag. Any vehicle parked on campus without a permanent decal or temporary hang tag is subject to a \$25 per day fine.

If you sell or donate your car, be sure to remove the decal. You could be held responsible for citations if the new owner parks illegally at UMass Lowell.

You may have only one current decal on your vehicle at any time. Please be sure to remove all old decals or be subject to ticketing.

The decal must be permanently affixed to your vehicle's window as described above. It cannot be placed on a card or piece of plastic and moved from one vehicle to another. Do not scrape off the decal and move it to another vehicle. This will invalidate the decal.

All non-residential UMass Lowell parking lots are open without restriction from 4 p.m. daily, and decals are not required after this time.

Refer to the map below for available parking locations by decal type—residents are restricted to the lots on the campus of their building and may not relocate to another campus except to locations marked as "open to all."
