Methodology in Brief

YouGov interviewed 669 respondents who were registered voters in Maine. These respondents were then matched down to a sample of 650 to produce the final dataset. The respondents were matched to a sampling frame on gender, age, race, and education. The sampling frame is a politically representative "modeled frame" of Maine registered voters, based upon the 2024 Current Population Survey (CPS) Voting and Registration supplements, and the 2024 National Election Pool (NEP) exit poll, including demographics and 2024 presidential vote. The matched cases were weighted to the sampling frame iterative proportional fitting (IPF) on the combinations of marginal 2024 presidential vote gender, age (4-categories), race (2-categories), and education (4-categories), to produce a registered voter weight. Finally, registered voter weights were then compared to expected proportions for likely voter profiles given a battery of three items in order slightly more weight than their unlikely voter counterparts. These included, 1) how closely they follow news about candidates running for the senate; 2) How often they say that they vote when there is a midterm election; and 3) how likely they are to vote in the election in November. Where the data were lower than expected, they were upweighted. The likely voter weights were then trimmed and centered.

UMass Lowell is a public institution and releases surveys as a source of public information. We offer a complete methodology report in adherence with standards of the AAPOR Transparency Initiative, as well an extensive set of crosstabs.
