Methodology in Brief

YouGov interviewed 751 respondents who were registered voters in Maine, then matched down to a sample of 650 to produce the final dataset. The respondents were matched to a sampling frame on gender, age, race, and education. The sampling frame was constructed by stratified sampling from the 2024 Current Population Survey (CPS) Voting and Registration supplements and the 2024 AP VoteCast exit poll, including demographics and 2024 presidential vote. All data were weighted to the CPS-VRS person weights on the public use file, with Hur and Achen reweighting adjustments to account for missing data within the voter registration and turnout fields. The matched cases were then iteratively proportionally fitted (IPF) on 2024 presidential vote choice. The final component of the IPF consisted of a three-way stratification of gender, age (4 categories), and education (2 categories), these demographics' associated marginals, and home ownership, to produce the final weight. Finally, weighted results were compared to expected proportions for likely-voter profiles given three items: how closely respondents follow news about candidates running for the Senate, how often they vote in a midterm election, and how likely they are to vote in the November election. Where the data were lower than expected, they were upweighted. The likely-voter weights were then trimmed and centered.
