





- **Info Session**: Friday, Feb. 13 from Noon to 12:45 p.m. via Zoom
- **Training Session**: Friday, Feb. 20 from noon to 2 p.m. via Zoom
- **One-on-one Training**: Feb. 23 to March 2 (faculty led, in person or Zoom)
- **Preliminary Round**: Tuesday, March 3 from 4 to 7 p.m. at [University Crossing](#).
- **Finals**: Friday, March 20 from 3 to 5 p.m. at [University Crossing](#).

The training sessions are open to all graduate students, while only advanced Ph.D. students are eligible for the competition itself.



History

- **2008:** First 3MT held at UQ with 160 competitors.
- **2009:** Expanded to universities in Australia and New Zealand.
- **2010:** Inaugural Trans-Tasman 3MT at UQ.
- **2013:** First global Universitas 21 (**U21**) 3MT competition.
- **2016:** Trans-Tasman renamed Asia-Pacific 3MT, with more regions.
- **2020:** 3MT goes virtual due to COVID-19.
- **2021:** 3MT held in both virtual and live formats globally.
- **Now:** 3MT is hosted by 900+ universities in 85+ countries.
- **2025:** 3MT @ UMass Lowell inaugurated.



Rules

- Presentations are limited to 3 minutes maximum and competitors exceeding 3 minutes are disqualified.
- Presentations are to be spoken word (e.g. no poems, raps or songs)
- Presentations are considered to have commenced when a presenter starts their presentation through either movement or speech
- A single static PowerPoint slide is permitted. No slide transitions, animations or movement, and is to be presented from the beginning of the oration.
- No additional electronic media (e.g. sound or video files) are permitted.
- No additional props (e.g. costumes, musical instruments, laboratory equipment) are permitted.
- The decision of the adjudicating panel is final.





Judging Criteria

Comprehension and content

- Presentation provided clear motivation, background and significance to the research question
- Presentation clearly described the research strategy/design and the results/findings of the research
- Presentation clearly described the conclusions, outcomes and impact of the research

Engagement and communication

- The oration was delivered clearly, and the language was appropriate for a non-specialist audience
- The PowerPoint slide was well-defined and enhanced the presentation
- The presenter conveyed enthusiasm for their research and captured and maintained the audience's attention



3MT@UML (2026) timeline

Feb 13: info session (12:00-12:45 pm) (Zoom)

Feb 20: training sessions (12:00-2:00 pm) (Zoom)

(open to all graduate students engaged in research)

Feb 23-Mar 2: one-on-one training (faculty led, in person or Zoom)

Mar 3: live on-campus preliminary round competition (4 to 7 pm)

(training sessions open to all graduate students engaged in research, only advanced PhD candidates eligible to compete)

Mar 20: live on-campus finals competition (3 to 5 pm) *(top 10 finalists from preliminary round)*

Mar 31: all winners present at UML Student Research Symposium

Apr 22: 1st place winner on to regional competition NAGS 2:00-4:00 pm ET (Zoom)

December : regional winner on to national competition (in person at CGS annual meeting)



