

Nintendo:

Before setting up your Nintendo console please find your device's wireless MAC address. If you already have the MAC address, then you can skip this video and register your device with the My Devices Portal. If you are unsure you can watch the video on registering a device with the portal. After your device is registered, connect to the UMassLowell network.

To find the MAC address of a Nintendo console please follow these steps:

1. Select the System Settings button from the main menu.
2. Scroll through the menu until you find the Internet tab.
3. Select this, and the MAC address will be listed under System MAC Address.
4. Your MAC address should be displayed on the screen with the label "Wireless MAC Address"
5. Write down the combination of letters and numbers exactly for reference later.

Once you have the MAC address of your Nintendo Console, as stated above; register it in the My Devices Portal. If you are unsure how to do this, please watch our video on registering a device.

Once you finish registration, connect to the UMassLowell network and finish wireless setup. Your Nintendo Console is now set up to connect to our Wireless network.
