## 1830

- Lowell's population approximately 6,500 (total school age population of 355)
- About 500 of which Irish (40-50 children were between the ages of 5-14)

## 1836

- Lowell's population approximately 18,000
- About 2,000 of which Irish and Irish-Americans (about 750 between the ages of 5-14 about 400 Irish children regularly attended school, which was comparable to Yankee children's school attendance)

## 1855

- Lowell's population approximately 37,500
- About 12,000 of which Irish and Irish-Americans (about 4,800 between the ages of 5-14)
