Motion to vote on #9 by Carol Myers. Seconded by Mary Gormley. Proposal was not approved (0 yes, 7 no, 1 abstain).

Motion to vote on #10 by Art Mittler. Seconded by Carol Myers. Proposal was not approved (0 yes, 4 no, 4 abstain).

Discussion: The committee recommends a policy to require a pre-requisite for 3000/4000-level courses.

The current policy: <u>https://www.uml.edu/catalog/undergraduate/policies/academic-policies/course-descriptions.aspx</u> doesn't say anything about 4000-level. The system doesn't enforce the policy as it is currently written. The Registrar's Office will not add a 4000-level course to the catalog without a pre-requisite.

Motion by Mary Kate Keyes to bring forward to Faculty Senate a policy change to require pre-requisites for 3000/4000-level courses. Requires Faculty Senate approval. Seconded by Carol Myers. Motion approved (7 yes, 1 no, 0 abstain).
